The history of the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers & Troopers Motorcycle Clubs (NABSTMC) began with a dream; in this case the dream of Ken 'Dream Maker' Thomas, believing that it was time to establish a modern day progressive motorcycle club whose focus was to promote a positive image. Thomas founded the Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club of Chicago in October 1993. The name Buffalo Soldiers was initially selected to pay homage and ensure the legacy of African American military contributions in the post Civil War era. Soon afterwards others showed an interest and started chapters, the next four being Florida, Delaware, Virginia and New Jersey. In 1999, the clubs collectively formed the NABSTMC which currently consists of seventy-nine chapters throughout the United States and internationally with additional clubs petitioning for membership yearly.

The NABSTMC is now an active participant in numerous charitable functions including supporting senior citizen homes, student scholarships and food and fund drives for charitable organizations, i.e. The March of Dimes and Toys for Tots. NABSTMC has also taken the responsibility of mentoring area youth and participating in local educational programs, which share enlightenment of the heritage -African Americans have played in the United States. We are also actively involved in recognizing the accomplishments and sacrifices of the Tuskegee Airmen. NABSTMC encourage a positive image and behavior of our members and affiliates. We believe that we are role models and share a responsibility in fostering a positive value system to our respective communities.

The Florida Mother chapter of the NABSTMC located in St. Petersburg Florida has granted six additional chapters throughout the state of Florida; South Florida, Central Florida, Tallahassee, Miami, Jacksonville and Orlando. Orlando was granted its chapter in September, 2007 under the leadership of David "Radio" Phelan and Evelyn "Softail" Benton, both members of the Florida Mother Chapter, realizing the need for a chapter in the Orlando area.
